

Annual parental feedback from ForSchools parental survey-March 2017

This is the second year that we have asked parents for their valuable feedback to enable us to help continue to improve what we do for children at Penair School. In 2015/16 we received 170 responses from parents. In March 2017 there were 315 responses from parents. The average positive response rate to questions where more than 85% of respondents agreed was 84% (69% last year).

Overall strengths are reflected in the areas of :

- Home-School Relationships
- The Learning Experience
- Making a Contribution
- Relationships of Staff and Other Pupils
- Well-Being
- The Summary School Experience

In terms of the highest percentage of responses from parents where parents either strongly agreed or agreed to the question that was posed, the highest levels of feedback were as follows:

Particular areas of strength:

I am kept regularly informed about my child's progress each half term (97%)

Staff expect my child/children to work hard and do their best (97%)

My child/children is/are not racially abused at school (96%)

The school teaches my child to respect people from different backgrounds, races, religions, etc (93%)

If ever I have a question, a problem or complaint about school matters I can approach someone in the school about it (93%)

The school gives my child/children information on how to deal with such things as alcohol and drugs (92%)

The arrangements for my child/children to settle in when they started at the school were good (92%)

Staff encourage my child/children to become mature and independent. (91%)


My child/children is/are well looked after at this school (91%)

The school helps me to understand the important role I have to play in my child's education (89%)

Key issues to address:

Of the 38 questions there was only one key issue to address from parental feedback - The school gives my child opportunities to make positive contributions to the community outside school.
