Dear Y11 students and parents/carers,

We appreciate that you will be very keen to know how this document will impact your examinations. Consequently, our aim is to share with you any adjustments that will be made to examinations as soon as possible. Staff are working very hard to review the information in their subject teams. Please rest-assured that every decision made will be in the best interests of our students.

We are mindful that trial examinations commence on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November and we want to impress on students the need to prepare thoroughly. Whilst the government's policy is that 2022 examinations should go ahead, we must anticipate further significant disruption. Therefore, we need to stress the importance that students give us their best efforts so that, if teacher assessed grades are required, as they have been in the previous 2 years, we have a set of trial examinations that reflect what a student can achieve at that time. An examination schedule has already been shared with year 11 students and personalised timetables have been distributed to students today.

After school revision sessions continue to be well attended. As a reminder, the schedule, up until half term, is as follows, and all are welcome:

Monday: Maths in C86, 2.45-3.45pm

Tuesday: English in C84, 2.45-3.45pm

Wednesday: Science in L70, 2.45-3.45pm

Thursday: English on Teams, 2.45-3.45pm

We also have a series of virtual study skills workshops running across the academic year. These are for students and parents. They start at 5pm and run for 35 minutes.
