Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you to ensure that you are fully informed of our end of term arrangements and to also thank you for your support over the academic year which I know has been challenging for students, staff and parents. We have had an extremely busy end to the year at Penair.

Recent events and successes have included 35 Duke of Edinburgh students completing their silver expedition completing a 35-mile hike from Minehead to coombe Martin over Exmoor over three days with 2 nights camping. Earlier this year 51 students completed their bronze award. In addition, and probably more importantly collectively the students have undertaken 962 hours of volunteering in our local community.

Our new year 6 induction days took place this week with 246 new students joining the school and they were well supported by our excellent year 9 student guides.

Students in year 8 visited the Royal Cornwall show and year 10's visited Truro College to get a taste of lectures and the type of day that a further education establishment will provide. For both events we received much positive feedback about our students from both members of the public and staff in the respective organisations.

Our year 11's completed their exams and congratulations to them all in what has been a difficult and disrupted few years for them we look forward to celebrating their results in August.

Friday 8 July saw our first Prize Day since 2019 and it was wonderful to celebrate with parents and students alike. We are grateful to our guest of honour Mayor of Truro Steven Webb for his inspiring words of wisdom for our young people.

In addition, this week we are running a full school Sports Day the first time since 2019 we hope that this will allow the students to take part in sport in both a fun and competitive environment. All students must take part in at least one event and our fingers are crossed for good weather.

Term finishes with Curriculum Enrichment Week for year 7-9 and Work Experience for year 10. I would like to remind our students that they are ambassadors for our school during this week whilst out in the public eye. Our expectations of their conduct and behaviour are equally as high of them as they would be in a normal week in school.

With the summer holidays fast approaching, we are aware that a lot of parents buy new uniform for their child ready for our next academic year. All students including year 11 are expected to be in full school uniform for September.
