

## Annual School Survey May 2022 Pupil feedback

The survey questions used a scale of 1 to 5:

- 1 - Strongly disagree
- 2 - Somewhat disagree
- 3 - Neither agree nor disagree
- 4 - Somewhat agree
- 5 - Strongly agree

\*Occasionally, some questions require a yes/no response

### **Students – 715 responses (80.2% of cohort) (717 responses last time – 78.2% of cohort)**

Year 7- 87.7% completion rate

Year 8- 84.5% completion rate

Year 9- 83.0% completion rate

Year 10- 65.5% completion rate

Year 11 pupils didn't complete the survey owing to GCSE exam preparation
