How are you marked?

What will the exams look like?

Bespoke Literature Paper 2 (1hr 30mins)

Lord of the Flies (30+4 marks)

Choice of two questions (character/theme). Choose one.

No extract given. You must consider the entirety of the text.

Power and Conflict poetry (30 marks)

Named poem will be printed. Compare to another poem from the cluster from memory.

There will be other texts there that other schools will study, make sure you find Lord of the Flies and Power and Conflict and ONLY answer these.

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How are you marked?

AO1: Read, understand and respond to texts. What will the exams look like?

Language Paper 1 (1hr 45mins)

One fiction extract.

Section A: Reading

- Q1 List four things. (4 marks)
- Q2 Language analysis (8 marks)
- Q3 Structural analysis (8 marks)
- Q4 Response to a statement and evaluation (20 marks)

Section B: Writing

Q5 – Description/narrative writing. Picture stimulus. (40 marks)

Revision clock

- Clock revision
- Colour coded based on memory
- Rehearse knowledge
- Visually reflects the increasing knowledge that is secure in the long-term memory
- Chunks literature texts into more a more manageable size!

Lord of the Flies

How to use:

1) In one colour, brain drain all information and time yourself for each section (e.g. three minutes). Do not revise beforehand. This reveals what information is safely in your long-term memory.

2) With another colour, add in any gaps of knowledge. Use your exercise book, resources on the internet (GCSE Pod), revision guides to help plug that knowledge. This reveals what is unsafe as it is in your working memory.


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Plants Use Glucose in Five Main Ways...


