Please Note: The Government cancelled all GCSE and other examinations for 19/20 and 20/21 academic years and used a teacher assessed approach. The school was in a strong position to support teachers across all subjects in both years and was able to present staff with a rigorous and robust process to making their teacher assessments in an evidence based manner that reflected the efforts of our students. These results are not directly comparable with previous or subsequent years so have not been included in the table above.
