Please note, the Government cancelled all GCSE and other examinations for 19/20 and 20/21 academic years and used a teacher assessed approach. The school was in a strong position to support teachers across all subjects in both years and was able to present staff with a rigorous and robust process to making their teacher assessments in an evidence based manner that reflected the efforts of our students. **These results are not directly comparable with previous or subsequent years so have not been included in the table above.**
